Greetings from Regional Remote Sensing Center – West, NRSC/ISRO!

As you are aware, our Centre has been instrumental in implementation of Space Technologies in Western India by carrying out Remote Sensing and GIS based activities at both regional as well as national level since 1987.

As a part of our organizational objectives, we have also led from the front in spreading awareness about the Space and allied Technologies to the masses through multifarious outreach activities. Imparting training to students of Engineering Colleges is a part of this endeavour, which our Centre has diligently been carrying out over the past years. Having shifted to a new campus in Jodhpur, we are well equipped to continue with the exercise with renewed zeal.

This year, we invite the students from your college to be a part of our focused summer training programme. Please note the following regarding the same:

1. The Summer Training Programme-2019 is scheduled from 15.05.19 to 28.06.19 at RRSC-W/ISRO Jodhpur.
2. Owing to limited resources, we are planning to conduct training for a limited number of students belonging only to Computer Science (CS/CSE/IT) streams.
3. The Summer Training Programme-2019 will be carried out full time. Thus, the participants have to ensure that they will carry out the projects assigned to them by working in our labs for the full duration of their project. No requests for leave will be entertained.
4. Students may be asked to work on the assigned projects in groups, based on the nature of project, so as to ensure optimum output therefrom.
5. RRSC-West shall not provide any stipend for the project.
6. RRSC-West shall not provide any facilities for accommodation or transport to the students.
7. Upon successful completion of the project and submission of a well-documented project report along with a presentation before the scientists, the students shall be provided with a certificate of completion of training.
8. Students may avail the canteen facilities on prevailing rates.
9. Once selected, students are expected to maintain exemplary discipline within the RRSC-West campus. The training is liable to be summarily terminated in case of any act of indiscipline.
10. The students have to abide by any rules that may be formulated in this regard during the course of the training.
11. No electronic devices are allowed in the campus for the students.

In this light, we request you to nominate 2 (Two) students from above stream for the Summer Training, 2019 programme. The final nominations may be sent no later than May 3, 2019 through post. Additionally, a scanned copy of the nomination letter should be sent by email to: training.rrscw@gmail.com. Please ensure that the nominations are made on the official letter-head of the institution and sent only through official mail IDs. The final acceptance shall be intimated through email before May 10, 2019.
